

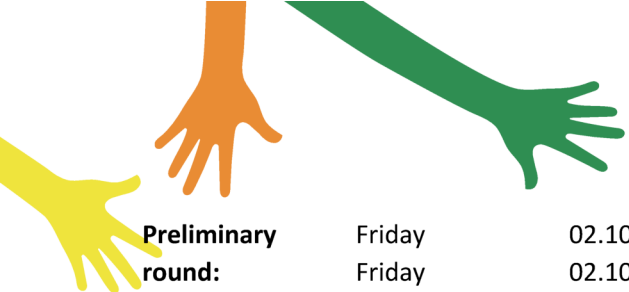


5. German Youth Open 2026

- Competitions:** Singles male B-Youth / Singles female B-Youth
Singles male A-Youth / Singles female A-Youth
Singles male Juniors / Singles female Juniors
- Approval:** The tournament has been approved as a "national tournament" by the DBU tournament director.
- Participants:** Eligible to start are all juniors and youth of the DBU, including the affiliated organization DBU Light, Bowl4Life and members of the EBF, who have their residence in the Federal Republic of Germany or other EBF member countries. In addition, starters from 3 other EBF member associations are eligible to start. Registrations from other nations must be rejected.
B-Youth who have not turned 15 before 30.06.2027.
A-Youth who have not turned 19 before 30.06.2027.
Juniors who have not turned 24 before 30.06.2027.
- Preliminary round:** 6 games American style of play.
Lane change after 2 games one lane pair to the right in the block.
- Final round:** The top 4 places after the preliminary round qualify for the final round in each competition. If there are fewer than 4 participants in a category, only the top two places from the preliminary round will advance to the final without a semifinal.
- The match for third place is canceled, and both semifinal losers are awarded third place and honored with training grants as shown in the overview.
- In case of a tie, the highest game and the lower difference between the highest and lowest game from the results of the preliminary round determines the better placement of the preliminary round.
- All final rounds are played in the "best of three" format, meaning that the winner of two games qualifies for the next round. The matches are played using European style of play and frame-by-frame scoring. In case of a tie, a roll-off (9th and 10th frame) will determine the winner. The better-placed player chooses the starting lane.

Refund of entry fees is only possible upon presentation of a written medical certificate and may be granted either partially or in the form of a credit voucher for the next tournament, depending on the cancellation timing. The decision rests with the organizers.

Training grants, etc.:

Total at least € 3.900,00

Each competition (male juniors/female juniors/male A-youth/female A-youth/male B-youth/female B-youth) plays into its own prize pool. Special awards, such as highest game, highest 6-game series, or first 300 game, are possible and will be announced no later than the final day.

When the offered competitions are evenly booked, the prize money is as follows: €190 (1st place), €135 (2nd place), €90 (3rd place), €50 (5th and 6th place), €40 (7th and 8th place), €30 (9th place), €20 per age category for highest game and highest series.

With higher or lower utilization, the total amount of prize money in each competition must/will be adjusted accordingly to ensure the overall prize money across all competitions.

The payment of training grants and special awards will be made only in cash on site.

It should be noted that prize money won may be subject to income tax. Any applicable taxes must be paid by the persons concerned in their own responsibility.
